## TE OROKOHAKA

In the hidden realms of te pō, Tama Kā embarks on his hīkoi up Aoraki mauka. With a whispered karakia from his tīpuna, his rikarika erupt with mana-infused ahi! A flick of his wrist and the sky is set ablaze, capturing the essence of te ahi kā! The whatumanawa of the people glow like kōwhaiwhai patterns, radiant with wairua, as they sense the mauri of new beginnings and untold adventures.

As Tama Kā's ahi starts to mellow, Rakinui pulses with wairua hihiko. From a portal of radiant light, Wahine Rikoriko descends. She waves her hand, and a korowai of pure light cascades across Papatūānuku, a radiant gift of aroha. The wairua of the tamariki take flight like manu, free to dream and tākaro under her veil of rakimārie.

Finally, answering an age-old karaka, Waipounamu steps forth. With a powerful pūkana, she strikes her mere pounamu into the whenua. The air resonates with an intense surge of ihi rakaraka, heralding te ahiahi and the rising of whetū. Whānau and hapū, pulled together by the magnetic aura of her mana, with pūrākau and kai, their souls are nurtured by her manaakitaka.








## HINE




